

Women's Golf Association 2017

Welcome to the Fox Bend Women's Golf Association. We are pleased that you plan to join us on Tuesdays, and we hope you enjoy the golf, special events, clinics, tournaments, and the camaraderie of league play. The Women's Golf Association includes both 9 and 18 Hole Groups. Advance sign-up, a tee time deposit, and handicap are required. **Payment deadline is April 11, 2017.** Prizes and points are awarded by flights.

Following is an overview of the Women's Association events, tournaments, and guidelines. Detailed information will be presented by the individual groups during the season.

Look Forward To:

Free Golf Clinic

The clinic is offered by the Fox Bend Professional Staff and will be one half hour in length. The focus will be to tune-up your short game.

Tuesday Points

Each Tuesday of league play "points" are awarded to both the 18 and 9 hole groups to reward good play; i.e. Low Gross, Low Net, Low Putts, or winners of other special events. Points are accumulated from May through September. Each point or fraction is assigned a monetary value and the total value is presented to each individual at the year end awards ceremony in the form of a Pro Shop gift certificate to be **redeemed** by June 30 of the following year. Weekly Events

Each group has developed games that will change each week and are in addition to Low Gross, Low Net & Low Putts.

Strokes for Charity

The purpose of the event is to raise money for a charity chosen by the winning team of each group. Details for the event are decided by the board of each group.

Final Association Event & Awards Banquet

The President's Event is an 18 hole event. This event will be planned by the 18 hole league president.

Tournaments

Hazel Linden Memorial Tournament

The tournament is so named in memory of the first president of the Fox Bend Women's Golf Association which began in 1967. The winner is determined by the Low Net Score for the day. Mim Wingate initiated the idea for the tournament and donated the plaque on which the winners names are engraved. The traveling trophies were donated by Hazel's husband, Ray.

Match Play

Match Play occurs on Tuesdays or any other mutually agreed day, June through August. Pairings and flights are determined by seeding. Players compete hole by hole using the Handicap Stroke Holes system. The winner of each hole is the player with the lower net score on the hole. Players with the most holes won in the first match (June) advance to second match (July). Winners of the second match advance to the third match (August). The loser of the first match (June) advances to the consolation bracket. All ties after 18 holes will start on Hole #1 and continue until there is a match winner. The first, second, and third place winners of each flight will receive their award at the year end awards ceremony.

The 9 hole group has chosen not to hold a Match Play.

Medal Play (League Championship)

The tournament is a stroke play event played on league day. Individuals are placed in flights according to their handicap. The champion in each flight is determined by the lowest total gross score. Awards for this tournament are presented at the year end awards ceremony. In the event of a tie after 18 holes, every effort will be made to continue starting on hole #1. If not possible, pro shop will assist in finding a playable hole.

The 9 hole group has chosen not to hold a Medal Play.

Remember

Sign-up in advance for a specific tee time on league day. If you are unable to keep your tee time, call the Pro Shop to cancel by 5pm on Monday. Refer to the advance tee time deposit policies.

Arrive 30 minutes prior to your tee time. If you have not checked in 15 minutes before your scheduled tee time, your spot may be given away. Early arrival facilitates both check-in and the pace of play.

Check the sign-up notebook each week for league information, tournament sign up, special announcements, tee times, course conditions, etc. Event & tournament results are posted on the bulletin board and the Fox Bend website. The sign-up notebook will remain in the Pro Shop and you may continue to sign-up two weeks in advance. You may sign-up on league day or call the Pro Shop.

Keep two scorecards, one for the tournament and/or event chairperson and one for the points chairperson. Cards should be signed by two players.

After play, you are responsible for recording your score on your point sheet, skins booklet, and chip-in's booklet. The handicap chair will post your adjusted score in the CDGA computer. 9 hole league players are responsible for recording their own scores.

Handicaps change every two weeks. You may print your handicap sticker at any time. If you need assistance, ask the Pro Shop staff for help. You can also check your handicap online.

Deposit and Handicap

Registering for a Fox Bend Handicap is a requirement of membership and for participation in association events. Fox Bend uses the Chicago District Golf Association (CDGA) System. The fee is \$29 and you may update your handicap on the computer in the Pro Shop.

The Fox Bend Preferred Player card will continue to be your source of Identification. Association Members will play at the resident rate on league day. Non-residents are entitled to resident rates for league play only. Residents are those living in Oswego, Aurora, North Aurora or Montgomery.

The two tee time advance deposit is required for League play. It works like this:

- Each Tuesday you play, you pay the regular green fee.
- Cancellations must be by 5:00pm the Monday prior to play day. If a player fails to show up and did not cancel by 5:00pm Monday, she will be charged a green fee against her deposit.
- If it is raining on Tuesday morning, and a player shows up and decides not to play because of the poor conditions, she will not be penalized a deposit.
- Same day cancellation by phone is permitted only if league play has been cancelled by the Pro Shop, golf professional, or league president.
- If you show up each week that you signed up to play, then you may use your deposit for your last two week's green fees. Unused deposits may be used toward a 2017 green fee, applied toward Pro Shop merchandise, or will be refunded by check at the end of the 2017 season.
